

**THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL**  
**(PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY NO. 6, WOOBURN)**  
**(TEMPORARY BRIDLEWAY CLOSURE) ORDER 2022**

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which will temporarily prohibit any person from proceeding on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle, except for access, in that length of Public Bridleway No. 6, Wooburn, which commences at its junction with Harvest Hill and continues to a point approximately 262 metres north east.

The closure is required whilst Swish Fibre installation works take place and it is anticipated that the works will commence on 4 May 2022 and will take approximately 21 days to complete.

The alternative route whilst the closure is effective is via the existing public highway network.

The Order will come into operation on 4 May 2022 when the appropriate signs are lawfully displayed and will continue for a period not exceeding six months or until the said works have been completed whichever is the earlier.

Penalties for not observing these restrictions will be as prescribed in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
